TRINITY

DEUTERONOMY 4

35 Unto you it was shown, that you might know that the L-rd he is G-d; there is none else beside him.

39 Know therefore this day, and consider it in your heart, that the L-rd he is G-d in heaven above and upon earth beneath, there is none else.

DEUTERONOMY 6

4 Hear, O Israel; the L-rd our G-d is one L-rd:

DEUTERONOMY 32

39 See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.

ISAIAH 42

8 I am the L-rd: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

ISAIAH 43

10 You are my witnesses, says the L-rd, and my servant whom I have chosen; that you may know and understand that I am he: before me there was no god formed, neither shall there be after me.

11 I, even I, am the L-rd; and beside me there is no savior.

ISAIAH 44

6 Thus says the L-rd the King of Israel, and his redeemer the L-rd of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no G-d.

HOSHEAH 13

4 Yet I am the L-rd your G-d from the land of Egypt, and you shall know no god but me: for there is no savior beside me.

ISAIAH 46

9 Remember the former things of old: for I am G-d, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,

ISAIAH 45

5 I am the L-rd, and there is none else, there is no G-d beside me: I girded you though you have not known me:

6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the L-rd, and there is none else.

18 For thus says the L-rd that created the heavens; G-d himself that formed the earth and made it; he has established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the L-rd; and there is none else.

EXODUS 33

20 And he said, You can not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.

PSALM 146

3 Put not your trust in princes, nor in the salvation of man, in whom there is no help. (Salvation)

EZEKIEL 28

9 Will you yet say before him that slays you, I am G-d? But you shall be a man, and no G-d, in the hand of him that slays you.

10 You shall die the deaths of the uncircumcised by the hand of strangers: for I have spoken it, says the L-rd G-d.

NECHEMIAH 9

6 You, even you, are L-rd alone; you have made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas and all that is therein,

and you preserve the all; and the host of heaven worship you.

1 CHRONICLES 17

20 O L-rd, there is none like you, neither is there any G-d beside you, according to all that we have heard with our ears.

ISAIAH 45

20 Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, you that are escaped of the nations: they have no knowledge that set up wood of their graven image, and pray unto a god that cannot save.

21 Tell you, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who has declared this from ancient time? Who has told it from that time? Have not I the L-rd? And there is no G-d beside me; a just G-d and a savior; there is none beside me.

22 Look unto me, and be saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am G-d, and there is none else.

HOSHEAH 11

9 I will not execute the fierceness of my anger, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am G-d, and not man; the Holy One in the midst of you, and I will not enter into the city.

1 SAMUEL 16

29 And also the strength of Israel will not lie nor repent: for he is not a man, that he should repent.

NUMBERS 23

19 G-d is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: has he said, and shall he not do it? Or has he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

EXODUS 20

2 I am the L-rd your G-d, which have brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

3 You shall have no other gods before me.
4 You shall not make unto you any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that in the water under the earth.

5 You shall not bow down to them, nor serve them: for I the L-rd your G-d am a jealous G-d, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; 6 and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

DEUTERONOMY 4

12 And the L-rd spoke unto you out of the midst of the fire: you heard the voice of the words, but saw no similitude; only you heard a voice.

13 And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, even ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tablets of stone.

14 And the L-rd commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and judgments, that you might do them in the land you go over to possess it.

15 Take you therefore good heed unto yourselves; for you saw no manner of similitude on the day that the L-rd spoke unto you in Horeb out of the midst of the fire.

16 Lest you corrupt yourselves, and make a graven image, the similitude of any figure, the likeness of male or female.

23 Take heed unto yourselves, lest you forget the covenant of the L-rd your G-d, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, which the L-rd your G-d has forbidden you.

24 For the L-rd your G-d is a consuming fire, even a jealous G-d.

DEUTERONOMY 7

25 The graven images of their gods shall you burn with fire: you shall not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto you, lest you be snared therein: for it is an abomination to the L-rd your G-d.

EXODUS 34

14 For you shall worship no other god: for the L-rd, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous G-d:

JEREMIAH 25

6 And go not after other gods to serve them, and to worship them, and provoke me not to anger with the works of your hands; and I will do you no hurt.

7 Yet you have not hearkened unto me, says the L-rd; that you might provoke me to anger with the works of your hands to your own hurt.

DEUTERONOMY 31

16 And the L-rd said unto Moses, "Behold, you shall sleep with your fathers; and this people will rise up, and go whoring after the gods of the strangers of the land, where they go to be among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them.

17 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, 'Are not these evils come upon us, because our G-d is not among us?'
18 And I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

ISAIAH 11

1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots:

2 And the spirit of the L-rd shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the L-rd;

3 And shall make him quick in understanding in the fear of the L-rd: and he shall not judge after the sight of eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

JEREMIAH 30

7 Alas, for that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even the time of Jacob's trouble; but he shall be saved out of it.

8 For it shall come to pass in that day, says the L-rd of hosts, that I will break his yoke from off your neck, and will burst your bonds, and strangers shall no more serve themselves of him:

9 But they shall serve the L-rd their G-d, and David their king, whom I will raise up unto them.

EZEKIEL 34

23 And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd.

24 And I the L-rd will be their G-d, and my servant David a prince among them; I the L-rd have spoken it.

EZEKIEL 37

23 Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them so shall they be my people, and I will be their G-d.

24 And David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

HOSHEAH 3

4 For the children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without a sacrifice, and without an image, and without an ephod, and without teraphim:
5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the L-rd their G-d, and David

their king; and shall fear the L-rd and his goodness in the latter days.

PSALM 2

1 Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?
2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the L-rd, and against his anointed, saying,

"All Trinitarians agree that the ideas about G-d expressed in the doctrine of the Trinity are not found directly in the Old Testament."

MARK 10

17 And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, "Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?"
18 And Jesus said unto him, "Why call you me good? There is none good but one, that is, G-d."

MARK 13

31 Heaven and earth shall pass away; but my words shall not pass away.
32 But of that day and hour knows no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the son, but the father.

JOHN 14

28 You have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you, if you loved me, you would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the father: for the father is greater than I.

TIMOTHY 2

5 For there is one G-d, and one mediator between G-d and men, the man Christ Jesus;

JOHN 20

17 Jesus said unto her, "Touch me not, for I am not yet ascended to my father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my father, and your father, and to my G-d, and your G-d."

1 CORINTHIANS 11

3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is G-d.

ACTS 5

38 And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:
39 But if it be of G-d, you cannot overthrow it; lest haply you be found even to fight against G-d.

SATAN

NUMBERS 22

22 G-d's anger was kindled because he was going, and the angel of the L-rd took his stand in the road as his **adversary**. Now he was riding on the donkey, and his two servants were with him.

1 KINGS 11

23 And G-d stirred him up another adversary, Rezon, the son of Eliadah, which fled from his lord Hadadezer king of Zobah:

25 And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the mischief that Hada did: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria.

2 SAMUEL 19

22 And David said, "What have I to do with you, you sons of Zeruiah, that you should this day be adversaries unto me? Shall there any man be put to death this day in Israel? For do not I know that I am this day king over Israel?"

JOB 1

6 One day the heavenly beings came to present themselves before the L-rd, and Satan also came among them.

7 The L-rd said to Satan, "where have you come from?" Satan answered the L-rd, "From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking up and down on it."

8 The L-rd said to Satan, "Have you considered my servant Job? There is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man who fears G-d and turns away from evil."

9 Then Satan answered the L-rd, "Does Job fear G-d for nothing?

10 Have you not put a fence around him and his house and all that he has, on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land.

11 But stretch out your hand now, and touch all that he has, and he will curse you to your face."

12 The L-rd said to Satan, "Very well, all that he has in your power; only do not stretch out your hand against him!" So Satan went out from the presence of the L-rd.

ZECHARIAH 3

1 Then he showed me the high priest Joshua standing before the angel of the L-rd, and Satan standing at his right hand to accuse him.

2 And the L-rd said to Satan, "The L-rd rebuke you, O Satan! The L-rd who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is not this man a brand plucked from the fire?"

3 Now Joshua was dressed in filthy clothes as he stood before the angel.

4 The angel said to those who were standing before him, "Take off his filthy clothes." And to him he said, "See, I have taken your guilt away from you, and I will clothe you with festal apparel."

5 And I said, "Let them put a clean turban on his head." So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him with apparel; and the angel of the L-rd was standing by.

2 SAMUEL 24

1 Again the anger of the L-rd was kindled against Israel, and he incited David against them, saying "Go, count the people of Israel and Judah."

2 So the king said to Joab and the commanders of the army who were with him, "Go through all the tribes of Israel, from Dan to Beersheba, and take a census of

the people, so that I may know how many there are.

1 CHRONICLES 21

1 Satan stood up against Israel, and incited David to count the people of Israel

2 So David said to Joab and the commanders of the army, "Go number Israel, from Beersheba to Dan, and bring me a report, so that I may know their number.

ISAIAH 45

7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the L-rd do all these things.

He (Satan) is clearly subordinate to G-d, a member of His suite (Heb. *bene ha-elokim*), who is unable to act without His permission. Nowhere is he in any sense a rival of G-d – **The Encyclopedia of Judaica**

2 CORINTHIANS 4

3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

4 In whom the **god of this world** has blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of god, should shine unto them.

Paul sees this world as a battleground in which Satan and his hosts contend with G-d and his forces for the lives of men – **The Interpreter's Bible Commentary**

JOHN 12

31 Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out.

JOHN 14

30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world comes, and has nothing in me.

JOHN 16

11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.

1 JOHN 3

8 He that commits sin is of the devil; for the devil sins from the beginning. For this purpose the son of god was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

EPHESIANS 6

11 Put on the whole armor of god, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rules of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

2 TIMOTHY 2

26 And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

JOHN 8

44 You are of your father the devil and the lusts of your father you do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not

in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

ACTS 22

16 But rise, and stand upon your feet: for I have appeared unto you for this purpose, to make you a minister and a witness both of these things which you have seen, and of those things in which I will appear unto you;

17 Delivering you from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send you,

18 To open their eyes, **and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto god**, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
